Prepaid Electric Service Continues to Spread in Oklahoma

Dallas, Texas – March 9, 2009:

Three more electric cooperatives in Oklahoma have announced plans to offer prepaid electric service to their members. Central Rural, Indian, and Kiamichi Electric Cooperatives will partner with Exceleron Software in implementing Exceleron's Prepaid Account Management System (PAMS), following in the steps of Oklahoma Electric Cooperative and Lake Region Electric Cooperative, which began implementing Exceleron's PAMS in 2006.

The web-based PAMS platform will provide Oklahoma's electricity consumers with an attractive alternative to the traditional 30-day postpaid billing environment. Consumers who opt for the prepay service can access their daily usage and account balance information via the phone, internet, or text messaging. Account holders can make payments whenever they like, selecting one of many convenient payment options.

Stillwater-based Central Rural Electric Cooperative, Cleveland-based Indian Electric Cooperative, and Wilburton-based Kiamichi Electric Cooperative serve 21,000, 18,000, and 20,000 members, respectively. Considering that Oklahoma Electric has more than 47,000 members and Lake Region Electric has 30,000 members, a significant percentage of Oklahoma residents and businesses can now choose to pay for electricity before they use it, avoiding surprisingly large bills and high deposits.

Because Exceleron integrates PAMS with cooperatives' existing billing and meter-reading systems, there is no need to purchase any additional hardware, software, kiosks, or in-home display units. This makes it a very cost-effective service that utilities can offer to the consumers with minimal upfront costs.

Jeff Severs, chief operating officer of Exceleron Software, attributes the growing popularity of PAMS in Oklahoma to enthusiastic endorsements from local utilities that are already offering prepay options to their customers. Charles Barton, the chief financial officer of Oklahoma Electric Cooperative, says, "We for sure think that prepaid is the wave of the future, and Exceleron is a good tool to make that happen." He sums up his enthusiasm by saying, "We're very pleased with our decision [to use PAMS] and we're moving forward with it."
